

Bargaining Talks Set for Monday In Strike by Legal Services Staff

A state mediator has scheduled a bargaining session for Monday in an effort to end a strike that has crippled service for the poor in civil legal actions in New York City since Nov. 14.

The strike, by 280 lawyers, aides and clerks represented by the Legal Services Staff Association, has forced Community Action for Legal Services to drop all but emergency litigations.

Solomon Kreitman, the mediator, set the Monday meeting for 2 P.M.
