Twenty-three demonstrators from Legal Services were arrested Thursday at the offices of Cleary, Gottlieb, Steen & Hamilton after staging a sit-in to protest lack of negotiations to end a three-week-old Legal Services Staff Association strike against Legal Services for New York. LSSA said that Christopher Lunding, a Cleary partner who is chairman of LSNY's citywide board, has stalled settlement of the strike by refusing to hold a meeting of the

board. Mr. Lunding said in an interview that meetings had been held the first three months of the year, at which aw union representatives voiced their views. The LSSA union, which represents LSNY lawyers, paralegals and support 17. staff, is seeking pay and pension increases, a contract provision barring sexual harassment and improved office an conditions. About 150 protesters assembled outside One Liberty Plaza, and approximately 30 demonstrators from ent LSNY's neighborhood project boards and the LSSA entered the building. Some of the protesters occupied the all firm's 38th floor reception area for two hours before being arrested, according to a Cleary spokesperson.
